113/16 Parish Council matters

- a) Tetney Lock – Request received for a commemorative bench to be place in Tetney Lock in memory of Helen Hippisley, depends on location for permission, Clerk to inform applicant. Highways have agreed to extend the 30mph zone. Yellow 30mph repeater signs, Cllrs to look at lighting columns to put signs on and direction to face. Clerk to ask LRSP for mobile speed camera in Tetney Lock.
- b) Village Hall/Toilets – Caretaker/Cleaner resigned from Hall, advert to go in Village Voice. Summer fair raised £700 towards play equipment. Tesco grant looking promising and new grant for green spaces being looked into.
- c) Cemetery, Churchyard and Jubilee Gardens – Headstone application approved for Mr Richardson, Clerk to inform Leakes that headstone base for Ms Whitehead needs to be reduced by 2” to comply with regulations. Clerk to inform Ms Watson 3 cremation plots will be charged at Villagers rate as a goodwill one off gesture, proposed by Cllr Winslow, seconded by Cllr Maynard, all in favour. Cllr Fletcher proposed £850 for a double Outsiders cremation plot, seconded by Cllr McMillan, 4 in favour, 1 against. Proposal carried.
- d) Allotments- One half plot still available.

- e) Footpaths, roads, trees, lighting and fly tip- Station Rd footpath strimmed under the hedge but the hedge has not been cut back. Caravan on North End Rd reported for obstruction and being lived in.
- f) Dog foul, litter bins, benches and notice boards - No report.
